## HANDOVER OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS – MUAPÉ PRIMARY SCHOOL AND NTETE COMMUNITY BUILDING

Syrah Resources completed two important local development projects in March, with a community building in Ntete village and the Muapé Primary School officially handed over to the Balama District Government in inauguration events attended by dignitaries including the Governor of Cabo Delgado, the Balama District Administrator, Host Community leaders and Syrah representatives.

The new school facilities represent a significant improvement on the existing infrastructure, with children now having access to fully equipped classrooms, recreational facilities, and improved sanitation, shelter and security conditions.

During the ceremony, the Company reinforced its ongoing commitment to contributing to the socio-economic development and sustainable growth of the local community, which is reflected in the Syrah Company Value of “**PARTNERING** with the **COMMUNITY** and **STAKEHOLDERS** for sustainability”.
