



SUSTAINABLE WATER ACCESS FOR SYRAH'S HOST COMMUNITIES

For many communities in rural Mozambique, access to clean drinking water is a serious challenge and is a leading cause of infant mortality. Many communities rely on shallow wells or other intermittent water sources which can often be a breeding ground for disease.

In partnership with our host communities and other stakeholders, our site Social & Environment team coordinated the installation of seventeen potable groundwater boreholes in Q4 2018. This project was fully endorsed by the Local Development Committee and supported by local government authorities.

The Company is thrilled to be given the opportunity to assist our host community partners to improve their access to clean drinking water and this program is testament to Syrah Resources' commitment to sustainable development, prioritised in line with the needs of the community and delivered in a way that engenders mutual benefit and trust.

The integrity of the new water boreholes will be closely monitored together with Village Water Management Committees and the Local Development Committee.
